JUNE 30, 1954

Under Regulations contained in Treasury Department Circular 940, effective February 17, 1954, changing the basis for reporting in the Daily Treasury Statement, this statement shows cash deposits and withdrawals as they affect the account of the Treasurer of the Uhited States. Receipts and expenditures of the U.S. Government on a budgetary basis showing surplus or deficit, previously shown daily are now reported separately, once a month, with the mid-month issue of the Daily Treasury Statement.
