<sup>2</sup> Statutory debt limit was changed by the Act approved June 30, 1959 from \$283 billion to \$285 billion. The limit, including temporary increases, was \$280 billion from February 26 to September 2, 1958; \$288 billion from September 2, 1958 to June 29, 1959; and \$290 billion on June 30, 1959. From July 1, 1959 to June 30, 1960, the limit is \$295 billion. Thereafter it will revert to \$285 billion.


