# **Daily Statement of the United States Treasury** OCTOBER 29, 1954 (LAST STATEMENT FOR OCTOBER)

Under Regulations contained in Treasury Department Circular 940, effective February 17, 1954, changing the basis for reporting in the Daily Treasury Statement, this statement shows cash deposits and withdrawals as they affect the account of the Treasurer of the United States. Receipts and expenditures of the U.S. Government on a budgetary basis showing surplus or deficit, previously shown daily are now reported separately, once a month, with the mid-month issue of the Daily Treasury Statement.

d Any income derived from Treasury bills of this issue, whether interest or gain from their sale or other disposition does not have any exemption, as such, and loss from the sale or other disposition of any such bills does not have any special treatment, as such, under the Internal Revenue Code or laws amendatory or supplementary thereto. The bills are subject to estate, inheritance, gift, or other excise taxes, whether Federal or State, but are exempt from all taxation now or hereafter imposed on the principal thereof by any State, or any of the possessions of the United States, or by any local taxing authority. For purposes of taxation the amount of discount at which the bills are originally sold by the United States

is to be considered to be interest.

<sup>e</sup> Income derived from these securities is subject to all taxes now or hereafter imposed under the Internal Revenue Code or laws amendatory or supplementary thereto.
